CLUB WOODBRIDGE MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

Section 1. Membership Classifications and Fees

*Seniors are aged 60 and up. These rates are based on paying in full.

- Single Membership \$265, Single Senior Membership \$235 Valid for one individual, for one year.
- Family Membership \$495, Senior Family Membership \$445 Valid for up to six immediate family members residing in the same household. For adults over 21, please provide proof of residency.
- Additional immediate family members may be added to either plan for an extra \$50 per year, per person.

Section 2. Dues/Payment Options

There are two options for paying membership dues:

- 1. Pay in full. Must be received and postmarked no later than 30 days of signing up.
- 2. Automatic Bank Draft. You may choose to have funds automatically withdrawn each month for one year. A separate form is needed to sign up for this option (enclosed in this package).

The rates for monthly drafts are as follows: Single Membership - \$21.95/month for 12 months Single Senior Membership - \$19.95/month for 12 months Family Membership - \$41.95/month for 12 months Senior Family Membership - \$37.95/month for 12 months

Section 3. Late Fees/Insufficient Funds

A \$25.00 late fee will be added to any payment seven days past due.

Payments returned for insufficient funds will be charged a \$35.00 fee. If member has more than two (2) incidences of insufficient funds or returned checks, payment will be required in money order or cash payment only.

Section 4. Membership Cards/Access to Amenities/Lost Cards

Within two weeks of joining, members will receive their membership card by mail or in person. Single memberships receive one key fob per membership and family memberships receive two key fobs per family with the option of adding up to four total at the cost of \$10/each. For lost or stolen cards please alert Club Woodbridge as soon as possible, there is a \$10.00 replacement fee.

Section 5. Pool

Hours: The pool is open from 12:00 PM to 8:00 PM daily, with a lifeguard typically present from 12:00 PM- 7:00 PM.

Rules: The rules are contained within this membership agreement. A copy of the rules is also provided in this agreement and can also be found at www.clubwoodbridge.com/rules. Members and guests are expected to abide by all pool rules and regulations.

Members/Guests in violation of these rules and regulations or with repeated offenses will be at risk for suspension and/or termination.

Section 6. Tennis Courts

All members and quests are welcome to enjoy the tennis courts on a first-come first-served basis. Members and quests must abide by all tennis court rules and regulations. Any one in violation of these rules and regulations may be at risk for suspension and/or termination. A copy of these regulations and rules are available upon request.

Section 7. Club House

Adult members and adult guests are welcome to enjoy the clubhouse and amenities on a firstcome, first-served basis. Children (under 16) are welcome to access to the clubhouse and amenities when accompanied by an adult.

The clubhouse is generally accessible when the pool is open unless it is being privately rented.

The kitchen is reserved for private events and employees only.

No wet bathing suits in the clubhouse. Please keep the doors closed during the summer (as we try to keep the inside cooler).

Section 8. Guests

Members must be up-to-date on all dues and fees and be in good standing with Club Woodbridge to have guests.

Members are welcome to bring quests for an additional \$5/day. Guests will be allowed admittance three (3) times. After the third visit member will be asked to join the club for continued use as a member.

Out of town guests (living farther than 35 miles) may use the facilities of Club Woodbridge if accompanied by a current member.

Event fees may apply if applicable.

Section 9. Host a Special Event at Club Woodbridge

The clubhouse, pool, and grounds are available for rent by both members and non-members. Members enjoy the perks of a 20% discount on facility rental. A rental fee shall be established at the time of each individual rental. A 50% deposit is required at time of signing with remaining due paid 24 hours to prior to event. Please see www.clubwoodbridge.com/events for more information.

Section 10. Events Hosted By Club Woodbridge

Occasionally, Club Woodbridge may host events, sometimes they are free to members and other times there may be an additional cost if members wish to attend or participate.

In the event that Club Woodbridge has accepted funds for a scheduled event and it must cancel due to unforeseen circumstances, members will be reimbursed 80% of any pre paid fees with 20% retained by Club Woodbridge for incurred cost. If incumbent weather cancels an activity or scheduled event, the activity or event will be rescheduled for a later date and no refund will be given.

Section 11: Termination or Suspension of Membership

Suspended and/or terminated members shall lose all rights to participate in club activities or use of facilities at the date of suspension and/or termination and must reapply for membership.

FOR LACK OF PAYMENT:

Any membership may be suspended in the event that he/she defaults on his/her membership dues within 30 days. A member whose membership has been suspended or terminated will be notified in writing. Members will have 30 days to apply for reinstatement. See more information below in "Reinstatement".

CONDUCT/ABIDING BY POOL & FACILITY RULES:

Inappropriate conduct or an infraction of the rules and regulations set forth by Club Woodbridge may constitute grounds for expulsion. Member(s) that has have habitual reprimands or inappropriate conduct may be permanently terminated. If termination occurs, prepaid dues are retained by Club Woodbridge. No refund is given at time of termination and/or suspension. Any unpaid dues at the time of termination are still owed with payment due in full within thirty (30) days of termination.

REINSTATEMENT:

If reinstatement is approved, dues will be required up front and paid in full at the time of reinstatement to include a \$25.00 reinstatement fee.

The reinstated member will be put on a temporary probation period of three months, within the three month probation period the member applying for reinstatement must not have any infractions or complaints made against them. Doing so could result in permanent termination.

SECTION 12. RESIGNATIONS

Any member wishing to resign their membership can only do so in writing 30 days prior to the annual renewal date of their agreement. Resignations will only be approved for members who are in good standing, with no debts owed to Club Woodbridge. If a member shall move more than 30 miles from the area, has terminal illness, or financial misfortune— written validation must be sent/submitted to Club Woodbridge 30 days prior to the planned date of resignation for approval by the club director.

CLUB WOODBRIDGE POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY

If emergency services are needed, dial 911 immediately. There is a service phone located in the grey box the along right side of fence as you walk to restrooms in the pool. Please Notify Life Guard on duty as soon as possible. Everyone must exit the pool.

2. FACILITIES & ACCESSIBILITY

- a. Children (members under 18) MUST be accompanied by an adult at all times. Parents may not leave children unattended at the pool for any amount of time.
- b. Chairs: Chairs are available on a first come, first served basis. Members may not reserve chairs for those who are not present. If you leave the premises, please take your belongings and allow another member to utilize the space.
- c. Parking: Please park along the road, at an angle to maximize space for others. Please do not pull into the yard beyond the tree line and/or block the walkway/sidewalks. Additional parking is available in front of the tennis courts along the street.
- d. Key FOB Access: Every member will be issued a key fob that will provide access to the pool and tennis courts. Lost or stolen key fobs can be replaced at the cost of \$10/each.
- e. Inclement Weather: For pool closures, please check your email and visit our facebook page (www.facebook.com/ClubWoodbridge2).
- f. Change to Hours: Club Woodbridge is available for party rentals and occasionally may close for maintenance. We will communicate via email as well as facebook if we shall ever need to adjust our hours/accessibility to the facilities. Thank you for understanding!

3. BEHAVIOR & CONDUCT

- a. Club Woodbridge is family-friendly! Please respect the small eyes and ears of our youngest members.
- b. Members are responsible for all personal items and belongings.
- c. Music should be tasteful and appropriate. Music with foul language and/or suggestive innuendos is not prohibited.
- d. No profanity.
- e. Lewd behavior will not be tolerated under any circumstances (i.e. foul language, nudity, intoxication).
- f. Wet swimsuits are not permitted in the Club House at any time.

4. POOL DECK/PATIO SAFTEY

- a. No Running, horse-playing, or rough-housing
- b. Leave walkways clear and free of personal items
- c. Glass containers are prohibited
- d. No climbing on or over the fences

5. SWIM RULES

- a. All Swimmers swim at their own risk
- b. Adults are encouraged to swim with other adults in the event of an emergency
- c. No diving in water less than five feet deep
- d. No hanging or pulling on the rope that divides the shallow and deep end
- e. Please do not tamper or play with the hose while water is being added to the pool
- f. Remove toys, floats, etc. from pool when no longer in use
- q. Do not jump or dive from ladders

6. DIVE WELL/DEEP END (5ft-9ft)

- a. Only one swimmer on the diving board at a time
- b. Do not hang from the diving board(s)
- c. Floats are not permitted in the diving area
- d. Ensure the dive well is clear of other swimmers before diving
- e. No loitering in the dive well
- f. On busy days, swim to the ladder closest to your diving board to ensure swimmer safety

7. KIDDIE POOL (1.5 feet deep)

- a. The kiddie pool is intended for children five and under
- b. A parent or quardian must be with the child/children at all times
- c. No diving or jumping in the kiddie pool
- d. Remove toys, etc. from the pool and/or deck when finished

8. FOOD & BEVERAGE

- a. Feel free to bring food and beverages for your enjoyment
- b. No food or drinks in or in or within five feet of the pool
- c. Consume food and beverage in designated areas only
- d. Glass containers are not permitted
- e. If you have a spill, please notify the guard for clean up

9. INCLEMENT WEATHER- For pool closures, please check your email and www.facebook.com/ClubWoodbridge2

- a. Lightning and thunder are cause for dismissal of all swimmers from the pool area
- b. High Wind situations requires that the lifequard remove umbrellas from the upright position in tables, to being stabilized on the ground
- c. With lifeguard's permission, swimmers are permitted to re-enter the pool after a minimum of thirty minutes has passed with the absence of lighting or thunder
- d. In the event of inclement weather, members are encouraged to wait in their car or return home

10. SANITATION & PRESERVATION

We would like for all of our members to enjoy the benefits of a clean, sanitary pool. We comply with the Center for Disease Control rules and regulations to ensure things continue to run at full capacity and preserve the health and life of our members as well as our swimming pools.

- a. Shower before entering pool to remove any germs and/or debris
- b. If you have long hair, please pull it back while using the pool. There are complimentary hair ties in the ladies shower room. We think long hair is beautiful, but it's been known to clog our pumps. Help us keep the pool up and running, without delays, all summer long!
- c. Swimmers who think they might be sick or are sick should not visit the pool. This includes pink eye, nasal/ear infection, diarrhea, etc.
- d. Only swim attire is allowed in the pool. The use of street clothes, jean shorts, basketball shorts, t-shirts, etc. are prohibited in the pool.
- e. Do not apply lotions or sprays while in the pool. Please apply your tanning lotion and/or sun block around ten minutes prior to entering the pool.
- f. Please do not change diapers in or around the pool (including on the lounge chairs and picnic tables). Please enjoy use of the changing table located in the ladies' shower room. Men are welcome to use the changing table as well-please check with lifeguard and he/she can ensure restroom/showers are free and clear.
- q. Diapers are prohibited in the pool. Incontinent swimmers should use swim diapers with appropriate, plastic containing swim pants.
- h. No pets in or around pool.

- i. No food or drinks while in the pool or within five feet.
- j. No Smoking in the pool area. For cigarette butts, there is a canister outside of the pool area, near the back entrance to the clubhouse.
- k. Please dispose of your trash.
- l. Please do not bring Styrofoam balls or really small items/toys into the pool area, as this could cause permanent damage to the pool pump.
- m. Do not manipulate or place objects in the pool jets.
- n. No Gum in the pool.
- o. Inability to adhere to the Club Woodbridge Rules & Regulations may result in suspension or termination of membership
